Medical Insurance Info:

All AYA students are covered by insurance and can receive care in hospitals and/or urgent care facilities. Insurance providers vary by country and overseas partner. Students received insurance cards and policy information prior to their departure from their home country. German, Austrian, and Swiss students (GIJ and CMP) should also contact CareMed partner in the U.S. – MedCare – to request an additional insurance card (see contact info in the table).

IMPORTANT: All students should be prepared to pay for medical visits out of pocket, and then submit a receipt for reimbursement from insurance. It is critical that the correct insurance company and contact information be given to the medical provider at the time of service.

Please see the reverse side of this document for additional information and insurance provider details. Whenever possible, be sure to confirm the student's insurance information prior to going to the doctor.
